Subject – **ENGLISH LITERATURE**

If you have completed all your English homework for the week then these are some additional activities that you should be working on outside of lessons (either in free periods, supervised study or at home). NC refers to activities that can be completed without a computer or where a computer is not absolutely required (non-computer) e.g. in the Conservatory.

- Creating a word bank/glossary of key words in relation to your novel/play/poems (NC).
- Reading articles from the www.newenglishreview.org/ website or the British Library website www.bl.uk/ that are related to your text (print out before Conservatory lessons).
- Creating character profiles/mind maps (NC).
- Creating a timeline for set novels/plays (NC).
- Reading more widely e.g. another text by an author you are studying (NC).
- Re-writing essays, incorporating targets (NC).
- Making lists of quotations, related to themes, characters or particular acts / chapters (NC).
- Re-reading set texts (NC).
- Sorting your folder/filing (NC).
- Reading through notes between lessons / reading ahead: a chapter / scene / poem (NC).
- Listen to relevant BBC podcasts.
